## 4 Matters Arising

Minerals & Waste Plan – The Chairman reported that he had received a reply from Nick Carter (WBC Chairman) explaining that it is not possible to give an exact timetable for a decision but it is unlikely to be before June/July 2018. As soon as it is available we will be informed.

**B3051** – MC has been in communication with Hampshire Council regarding the change to the speed limit on the B3051 and will continue to pursue the matter. **MC Gigaclear** – DB reported that the box currently outside Elmet House is to be relocated and an agreement has to be obtained with Highways; DB has asked that they contact him before moving the box.

## 5 Neighbourhood Development Plan

The Councillors agreed that there was no need in this Parish for such a plan because it is well served by procedures already in place such as the Parish Plan and the Village Design Statement. DC proposed that having considered the implications of the Neighbourhood Plan, it should not be adopted now but could be considered again in five years. The Councillors voted in agreement to this proposal.

# 6 District Councillor's Report

A further round of consultation from the Local Government Boundary Commission is now in process for electoral reform and DB outlined the manner in which WBC will be responding. Brimpton Parish Council viewed the draft recommendation as a very negative move and will submit objections to the proposals. However, it was viewed as a necessary move to contact Aldermaston and Bucklebury Parish Councils to ensure a united approach – DB agreed to do this.
