

# Competitions Schedule

## Brimpton Fete 2019

**29 June 2019, 2pm – 6pm**

**Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead at all times.**

**DEADLINES:** Having previously created your entries, simply bring them along on the day with a completed Entry Form and relevant fee.

**Fancy Dress** - Registration will be from 2pm.

Judging and prize giving will take place at 2.15pm in the Main Ring.

**Dog Show**- Registration will run from 2.30pm.

Judging and prize giving will start at 3pm.

**All other competitions** – Please bring your entries to the Booking Table between 10am and 12 o'clock. Scarecrows will be judged by everyone attending the fete between 2 and 4.30pm. The winner will be announced at 5pm. All other judging will take place at 1pm. Exhibits and prizes must be collected between 5 - 5.30pm on the day. Any item or prize that is not collected by 5.30pm will be contributed to the proceeds of this event.

### **1. FANCY DRESS – The Theme is History**

Open to all children up to the age of 11. Judging will start at 2.15pm.

Entry is FREE, prizes and rosettes will be awarded for the first, second and third places.

### **CRAFTS SECTION – FAMILY OR COMMUNITY GROUP**

Open to families, friends or community

### **2. Build a Scarecrow (no minimum height, maximum height 6 feet)**

Be as creative as you like, scarecrows do not have to be large or of a traditional design but must be free standing. Entry fee £1, first prize only, £25. This competition will be judged by everyone attending the Fete between 2pm and 4.30pm. The winner will be announced at 5pm.

### **3. Build a Bird Box using mainly recycled or upcycled materials**

Entry fee 50p. 1st prize £3, 2<sup>nd</sup> prize £2, 3<sup>rd</sup> prize £1

## **PHOTOGRAPHIC SECTION - OVER 16**

Open to everyone over 16. Entries should be from amateur or hobby photographers only. The maximum size for all photographic entries is A4. Photographs can be in colour or black and white and must be mounted on card for display purposes.

Entry fee is 50p, 1<sup>st</sup> prize £3, 2<sup>nd</sup> £2, 3<sup>rd</sup> £1.

### **4. My Family**

This topic is open to interpretation. It could be your pets, a grandchild or a family member or group.

### **5. Brimpton**

This could be a landscape, a building, local industry, a group of locals anything that says Brimpton!

## **PHOTOGRAPHIC SECTION- AGES 11-16**

Open to everyone between the ages of 11 and 16. The maximum size for all photographic entries is A4. Photographs can be in colour or black and white and must be mounted on card for display purposes. Entry fee is 50p, 1<sup>st</sup> prize £3, 2<sup>nd</sup> £2, 3<sup>rd</sup> £1.

### **6. The Natural World**

This could be a flower, an animal, a field, woodland, a garden, or a landscape

## **CRAFT SECTION – 11 -16**

Open to everyone between the ages of 11-16. Entry fee is 50p, 1<sup>st</sup> prize £3, 2<sup>nd</sup> £2, 3<sup>rd</sup> £1.

### **7. Make a Greeting Card**

You may use any medium to create your card. Maximum size of A5.

### **8. Make a Model Animal using Fruit and Vegetables**

You may use product like cocktail stick to join your model together

## **UNDER 11 - CRAFTS SECTION**

Open to everyone under the age of 11. Entry fee is 50p, 1<sup>st</sup> prize £3, 2<sup>nd</sup> £2, 3<sup>rd</sup> £1.

### **9. Make a Greeting Card for any Occasion**

Be creative – you can use any medium that you like.  
Cards should be no larger than A4.

### **10. Paint a Face on a Pebble**

You can use any medium to paint your pebble

### **11. Make a Toy Scary Monster using Socks**

Socks must be clean. You may use buttons, and stitching if desired

### **12. Make a Model Animal using Fruit and Vegetables**

You can use cocktail sticks or other items to join the vegetables together.

### **13. A Flower Arrangement in a Jam Jar**

Use your favourite flowers and colours. Arrange in a jar with the label removed.

## **COOKERY – AGES 11-16,**

Open to everyone between the ages of 11 – 16. Entry fee is 50p, 1<sup>st</sup> prize £3, 2<sup>nd</sup> £2, 3<sup>rd</sup> £1.  
All food entries should be cold when judged. Cakes should be displayed on a paper plate and covered by a plastic bag or cake cover. No fresh cream can be used.

### **14. Bake 5 Identical Creatively Decorated Cupcakes**

### **15. Using the Recipe Provided Bake Five Chocolate Brownies**

Makes 9 - 12 brownies

**INGREDIENTS:** 200 grams dark chocolate (roughly chopped), 175 grams unsalted butter, 325 grams caster sugar, 130 grams plain flour, 3 eggs, icing sugar (to decorate)

#### **METHOD:**

- Preheat oven to 170 degrees C fan, (325 F) or Gas 3.
- Melt chocolate and butter in heatproof bowl over a pan of simmering water. Remove bowl from heat. Add sugar until well incorporated.
- Add flour and stir until well incorporated. Stir in the eggs and mix until smooth.
- Put the mixture in a baking tray around 24cm x 24cm x 5cm (give or take a few cm) lined with greaseproof paper.
- Bake for 30 - 35 mins until cooked. Leave to cool and dust with icing sugar.

## **COOKERY OVER 16**

Open to everyone over the age of 16. Entry fee is 50p, 1<sup>st</sup> prize £3, 2<sup>nd</sup> £2, 3<sup>rd</sup> £1.  
All food entries should be cold when judged. Cakes and bread must be displayed on a paper plate covered by a plastic bag or cake cover. No fresh cream can be used.

### **16. Using the Recipe Provided (see above number 15) Bake Five Chocolate Brownies**

#### **17. A Jar of Fruit Jam**

Jars must have an airtight lid or covering and all commercial labels must be removed.  
Jam must be labelled stating content, month and year of making.

#### **18. Bake a Victoria Sandwich**

Use your own recipe and bake in a 7-inch tin.  
Fill with raspberry jam and decorate only with castor sugar.

#### **19. Bake a Loaf of Bread**

Any recipe may be used

## **20. NOVELTY DOG SHOW**

**Dogs should be kept on a lead at all times.** The Dog Show will take place in a dedicated show ring. No age restriction for dog handlers, but children should be supervised by an adult. All entries are at owners own risk. Registrations will be taken from 2.30pm on the day, and judging will take place from 3pm. Doggy Goody Bags will be awarded together with a certificate and rosette for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> place will be awarded with a Highly Commended Certificate.
